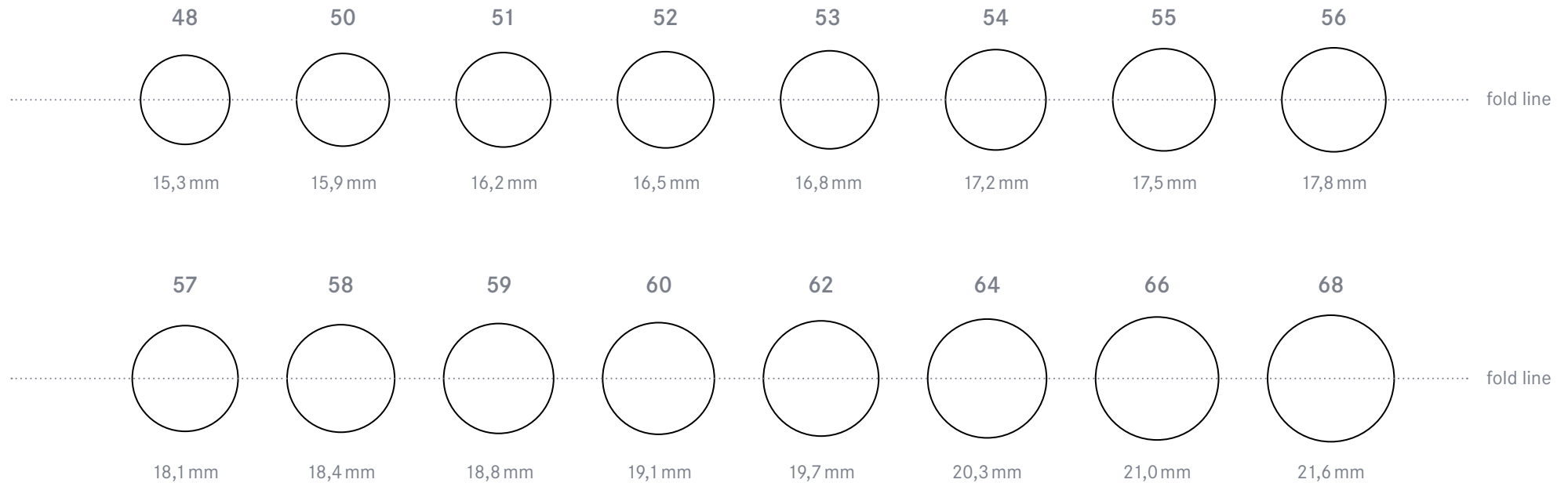


Template for determining your ring size



How to determine your ring size:

The number above the circle indicates the circumference in mm (= ring size)

The number below the circle indicates the diameter.

When you fold the paper on the dashed line, you can easily cut out a semicircle along the circle line. This creates a round neckline that allows you to measure your ring size. Make sure that the part is firmly attached to the finger on which the ring should be worn. Above the knuckle, the neck may be slightly taut.



Print this page in landscape format on DIN A4 paper. Under the page settings, do not select a printer fit so that the page prints in the original size. This reference line must be 5 cm long.
